



## Alliance Soccer Club U10 Teams Fee and Payment Schedule for 2010-2011

The annual cost to participate on a U10 team in the Alliance Soccer Club is \$640. This amount covers all costs for the year, including winter indoor training. The only additional expenses not covered in this fee are uniform costs, and any winter indoor league play - not to be confused with winter indoor training.

**UNIFORMS:** Cost for the basic uniform (two jerseys, one pair of shorts, two pairs of socks) is \$118. The club is going to a brand new uniform style this year, so all players will need to order a new uniform. The shorts and socks offered by the club will be the only style permitted to be worn during games (i.e. other types of black shorts and socks will not be allowed). Other uniform pieces can be ordered as well (warm-up suites, duffel bags, soccer backpacks). T-shirts, hoodies, ball caps, visors, and beanies with the club logo on them will be available for purchase as well.

The Alliance Soccer Club is offering 3 different options to pay the \$640 annual fee for the 2010-2011 season:

### **OPTION 1: PAYMENT IN FULL**

Accounts that are paid in full at the beginning of the season receive a 5% discount (\$608 total due)

### **OPTION 2: QUARTERLY PAYMENTS**

Four (4) equal payments of \$160.00, due on July 5, 2010; September 5, 2010; January 5, 2011; and March 5, 2011. You can elect to be invoiced for these payments, or you can arrange for automatic payment by credit card.

### **OPTION 3: MONTHLY PAYMENTS FOR A 10-MONTH PERIOD**

Ten (10) equal payments of \$64, due on the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month, beginning July, 2010, and ending April, 2011. This option is **ONLY** available if payment is being made by credit card.

If a player is joining the team after the due dates indicated above, all previously due payments are payable upon acceptance of the roster offer. Arrangements can be made to spread out the payment of this amount if needed.

In addition to this amount, an Initial Deposit of \$200 is also collected, and is due when your child accepts a roster position. One-half of this deposit is returned to you at the end of each of the fall and spring seasons if the required number of shifts have been worked in the concession stand during the season.
